Note: There will be no brush collection during November and December.

On another note, there are only one remaining mowing day scheduled for Oct. 31st. There could be additional mowings' in November if grass conditions merit mowing.

- Clean, cover and store your BBQ Grill & Outdoor Furniture
- Winterize your Sprinkler system
- Turn off the Exterior Faucets at the interior shut off values
- Cleanout all Gutters and Downspouts
- Seal any Windows and Doors for leaks
- · Have your Dryer Vent cleaned out
- Clean out and organize your Garage for your vehicle(s)
- Service your HVAC system and replace your filter monthly or quarterly
- Have you Automobile Battery and Tires check (replaced if needed)

Snow Removal Services

With winter just around the corner, residents are responsible for any snow or ice events which accumulates less than 3 inches on sidewalks in accordance with the FHOA's Governing Documents.

Herman's Landscaping provides snow & ice removal services when snow & ice accumulations are 3 inches or less. The cost for the service is \$35.00 per occurrence. If there is freezing ice involved in the snow removal, there will be an additional charge and if you would like ice melt spread on your property, please request this additional service.
