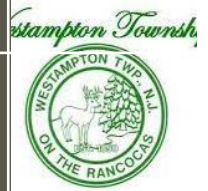

OFFICER SPOTLIGHT: PTL. MORAN

My name is Michelle Moran and I have been a law enforcement officer for 17.5 years, serving in the Westampton Township Police Department since November 2013. Prior to working in Westampton, I was a police officer in Edgewater Park Township for 8 years and at the Burlington County Sheriff's Department for one year. I began my career in Westampton working in the patrol division and in September 2018, I became the School Resource Officer at Burlington County Institute of Technology. This position has given me the privilege of being a mentor to female students in the Leading Ladies club as well as organize a 'mock crash' during prom season, which demonstrates to the senior students the life changing ramifications of operating a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol. In addition to promoting school safety, I am dedicated to the well-being of all of the students and staff at the school. I truly enjoy working with the youth in the community and being able to provide them with helpful resources for them to achieve their goals.

Aside from my responsibilities at the school, I am the department's Domestic Violence Liaison to Providence House, I have served in the Traffic Unit enforcing motor vehicle laws, and I am currently in charge of the Community Policing Unit.

I grew up in Burlington Township and moved to Westampton in 1995. In 2002, I graduated from Rancocas Valley Regional High School and enlisted in the New Jersey Air National Guard. I am still proudly serving in the New Jersey Air National Guard part time at Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst in the 108th Operations Support Squadron as a Technical Sergeant in Aircrew Flight Equipment. In 2019, I achieved an Associate's Degree in Applied Science from The Community College of the Air Force. I have had the opportunity to travel to several territories and countries including Guam, Scotland, England, Germany, Qatar, and Afghanistan. I will be retiring soon after 20 years of military service to this great country.

I am married to my patient and loving husband, Francisco, who is also a police officer in Gloucester County. Together, we have 2 year old daughter, who is the absolute light of our lives, and a 6 year old dog named Blue. When I am not working, I enjoy spending quality time with my family and entertaining at my home, cooking, and graciously serving on the leadership team at my church.

I have enjoyed meeting different residents over the years and look forward to meeting many more. I have seen the department's relationships with residents and local businesses flourish over the years, and my hope is that the bond continues to strengthen through community partnerships and mutual trust.

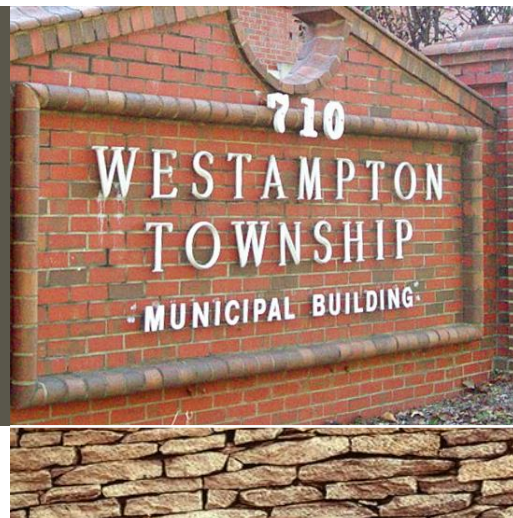
